### Summer Worship

For the summer months, the Board of Deacons and Pastor Ron decided to continue the worship schedule we began to use last summer. **Beginning on July 1, we will hold two worship services on Sunday mornings, one at 8:00 a.m. and another at 10:00 a.m.** The 8:00 a.m. service will continue as it always has, brief worship which includes a hymn, sermon and communion. The 10:00 a.m. service will alternate between our traditional worship and our TGISunday worship style. The worship services on July 8, July 22, August 5, August 19, and September 2 will be in our TGISunday style with music leadership provided by Branches. # Pastor Ron's Message

Growing up in a Baptist church in North Carolina, the Bible has always been an important part of my life. My understanding of this sacred book has changed over the years as I have continued to embrace the Bible spiritually and explore it academically, but it remains the most significant foundation of my faith.

In a sermon series this summer, I will offer sermons that explore five biblical passages that I often turn to when the questions of life press in on me. They are the Bible verses that I always keep in my pocket. Some of the passages may be familiar to you—others may not. As part of this sermon series I will invite you to consider the Bible verses that help form the foundation of your faith. I am calling the sermon series:

## ***Building on a Strong Foundation: The Bible and Faith***

July 1: *Rolling Waters*, [Amos 5:18-24](#)

July 8: *The Marks of a Christian*, [Romans 12](#)

July 22: *Surely Goodness and Mercy*, [Psalm 23](#)

I hope you will join me this summer as we explore the foundation of our Christian faith that we find in some of the most beloved, and challenging, passages in the Bible.


